INTRODUCTION

Water is connected to every form of life on earth. As a criteria, adequate, reliable, clean, accessible and safe drinking water supply has to be available to every citizens. The policy thrust of His Excellency Governor Yahaya Bello on water and sanitation is to improve the quantity, quality and access to safe water for domestic, commercial and industrial uses as well as improve sanitation and hygiene practices among the citizens for reduced morbidity and mortality rates, thereby achieving a path to sustainable growth and development in Kogi State. This is embedded in the Sustainable Development Goal 6 (SDGs), which the New Direction Blueprint subscribes to.





From His Excellency's speech at the swearing-in of his cabinet members, he said and I quote, "The New Direction Blueprint is my roadmap for accelerated development of Kogi State in all her constituencies and I charge you to study it, understand it and implement it. The 5 thematic areas will remain, but we are pulling out 4 former sub-thematic areas and making them full-fledged in this 2nd Term. These are Human Capital Development, Cooperation and Integration in Kogi State (EBIGO Agenda), Security and Agriculture. Bring your suggestions to the table and they will be given fair consideration, but run my Blueprint and not your agenda if you want things to remain fine with you".





In the last 2 years, The Ministry of Water Resources under my watch have conscientiously and meticulously carried out programmes and projects with regards to the policies outlined in the Blueprint in other to meet her targets and expected outcomes for the growth and sustainable development that the vision of his Excellency envisaged for the sector.

This report sets out to provide details of notable achievements of the Ministry of Water Resources within the last 2 years. They include increased volume of safe drinking water produced; increased access to safe drinking water; reduced water loss and wastages from water pipelines and network; reduced prevalence rate of water borne diseases and water wastage.





It is worthy to note that prior to the New Direction Administration, Kogi State was rated as the 34th State on open defecation in Nigeria, but with the massive sensitization programme on war against open defecation carried out by the Ministry, Kogi State is now ranked 2nd in Nigeria as regards Open free Defecation (Federal Ministry of Water Resources).





The achievements of the Ministry of Water Resources are further broken down into two categories subject to the status of completion.
